## CARDBOARD BOAT CHALLENGE RULES

- 1. Applicants are subject to review and approval by the Canyon Lake Woman's Club (CLWC), Failure to comply with any Cardboard Boat Challenge Rules and Regs may result in elimination and possible exclusion from future Cardboard Boat Challenges.
- 2. Advanced cardboard boat challenge registration greatly encouraged (DEADLINE, SEPT 19)
- 3. Vessels arriving for check-in which have not been registered by SEPT 19, 2019 are subject to space permitting AND \$10 entry fee per boat.
- 4. All participants must wear a coast guard approved personal floatation device (PFD) NO EXCEPTIONS
- 5. Eligibility to win the FIRST PLACE FINISH. Boat must remain afloat for the duration of the race. No tipping/rolling or swamping. All passengers must remain inside the boat for the duration of the race. Boat must be the first to cross the finish line.
- 6. Eligibility to win the FIRST PLACE FINISH (YOUTH). ALL PASSENGERS MUST BE UNDER 15 YRS. OF AGE. Any passenger who looks like he/she could be 15 must bring proof of age. Boat must remain afloat for the duration of the race. No tipping/rolling or swamping. All passengers must remain inside the boat for the duration of the race. Boat must be the first to cross the finish line.
- 7. Eligibility to win BEST DRESSED VESSEL. Boat must be decorated according to a Mermaid/Nautical or Pirate theme, extra consideration will be given for passengers dressed to match. Boat does not have to win the race but MUST finish.
- 8. ONLY DUCT TAPE OR CARDBOARD NO OTHER MATERIALS CAN BE USED INCLUDING PAINT & WAX FINISH AND PRINTED MATERIALSWWW
- 9. PRE-RACE AND/OR POST RACE TECHNICAL BOAT INSPECTIONS WILL BE CONDUCTED. We will be looking for any materials used that are not duct tape or cardboard. This includes any product that may be used to color, seal or waterproof the boat. No other materials can be used, even for flags. Winner of FIRST PLACE will be inspected and will be disqualified if materials used do not conform.
- 10. Boat may be used for advertisement purposes but may not be used as a political platform and no vulgar depictions will be permitted. Signage can only be made from cardboard and duct tape.
- 11. Boat sides must be 10 inches tall or greater and must have a solid bottom.
- 12. Legs and feet are to be contained inside the boat at all times.
- 13. Boat may only be propelled by utilizing arms, hands, paddles and/or oars. No motors, propellers, push poles, towing, dragging etc.
- 14. Destruction of rival boat entries will not be tolerated. No deliberate splashing, water balloons, squirt guns etc.
- 15. RACE APPLICANT LISTED IS RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVAL OF BOAT AND OR DEBRIS FROM INDIAN BEACH BY CLOSE OF FESTIVAL.
